It is now recognised that mycotoxin problems exist throughout the world. Mycotoxins can be hepatotoxic and carcinogenic to both animal and humans. The feed industry needs new solutions, more efficiently than mineral clays which have been used for many years (with high inclusion rates and guilty to bind nutrients such as vitamins and therapeutics). An example of such solution is the now-patented use of yeast-derived glucans as mycotoxin binder in animal feeds.
