



Observații privind originile unor termeni agricoli în limba română și alte limbi indoeuropene

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Aspects regarding the origins of the vocabulary specialised in agriculture In their attempt to establish the main word formation possibilities, the authors realise a complex etymological analysis of more than 50 words – names of crops, fruits, plant organs and seeds. Thus, one can easily notice that the weight of the Latin element in different agricultural branches is variable, a fact which points out the greater or lesser mobility of the presented realities. So, besides the Latin elements an important part is played by words of other origins, the authors attempt to discover the indoeuropean or not indoeuropean origins of the most part of these elements and their implications for the teaching of technical agricultural foreign languages.
