Aspects regarding the origins of the vocabulary specialised in agriculture. In their attempt to establish the main word formation possibilities, the authors realise a complex etymological analysis of more than 50 words – names of crops, fruits, plant organs and seeds. Thus, on can easily notice that the weight of the Latin element in different agricultural branches is variabile, a fact which points out the greater or lesser mobility of the presented realities. So, besides the Latin elements an important part is played by words of other origins, the authors attempt to descover the indoeuropean or not indoeuropean origins of the most part of these elements and their implicationes for the teaching of technical agricultural foreign languages.
