In their attempt to establish the main word formation possibilities, the authors realise an etymological analysis of more than 50 words - names of crops, fruits, plant organs and seeds. Thus, one can easily notice that the weight of the Latin element in different agricultural branches is variable, a fact, which points out the greater, or lesser mobility of the presented realities. So, besides the Latin elements an important part is played by words of other origins, and the authors attempt to discover the Indoeuropean or not Indoeuropean origins of the most part of these elements, with a special focus on the Slavic origin.
