



Problema agrara din Romania in timpul razboielor balcanice

During the first decade of the past century, the situation of agricultural property repatriation in Romania, preoccupied more and more the leading groups. The revolt proved the growing concern of political factors. The agrarian laws introduced by the National liberal Party consequent to the 1907 revolt proved to be inefficient in the attempt to balance the relationships between the great land lords and the peasants, for the development of agriculture. Our research indicates the fact that the unleash of the First Balkan War in 1912 was not determined by the decision of political parties in their intention of implementing a large scale agrarian reform, but precipitated this situation. Another contributing element was the possibility of the modification of the balance between the states in the region with main agrarian economy.
