Influenta conditiilor istorice, sociale si politice asupra evolutei structurilor agrare din Romania

The great diversity of the historical, social and political conditions influenced the evolution of the agrarian structures on the present territory of Romania. Along the history there are known several periods when transformations with an impact upon the agrarian structures occurred: the Ancient Age, the Feudal Age and the Modern Age.

In the modern age there are noticed several events which determined major changes in the property types and in the exploitation systems beginning with the agrarian reform of 1864, and going on with the one of 1921, the reform of 1945, the forced co-operativization between 1949 – 1962 and the Romanian Revolution of 1989. The main evolutions and transformations of the Romanian agriculture are presented and analyzed according to the periods and the events taken as reference points.
