



Efectul tarlirii, ca metoda de fertilizare a culturii marului, asupra cantității productiei de fructe

Sheep waste spreading is a method of organic fertilization, which consists in maintaining the sheep on the same territory for a period of some nights (2, 3 or 4 stationary nights). The sheep are kept in some specific barraged area.

In established fruit gardens of apple from Bistra Valley, sheep waste spreading is a method of fertilization often used due to the fact that it is the cheapest technique, non-polluted. Using this process the transportation of manure it is eliminated. Also, this technique shows some results even from the first year.

Apple production of fruits can fluctuate from year to year with soil type, crop system used, protection measures applied in fruit gardens and with climatic conditions from the relevant year.
