How to apply:

Please send the following documents to the international office:

- CV/Resume
- Motivation letter (mention the programme you wish to study)
- Copy passport or scan of the front and back of your ID card. If you have an EU residence permit, please send a scan of the front and back of this card as well.
- Most recent transcript of records/list of marks.
- English language test result (Only TOEFL, IBT, IELTS, Cambridge or OLS can be accepted)

These documents will be forwarded to the application committee. When they are positive about your application you will be invited to participate in an intake interview with the course coordinator.

After that our Erasmus/Exchange officer is able to sign your Learning Agreement.

To start in September, your learning agreement must be signed by all parties before the 1st of July.

To start in February, your learning agreement must be signed by all parties before the 1st of December.

After admission we will inform you on the housing possibilities.
