2. Nominated students receive by e-mail their login details to our online application form that they have to complete within the deadline above. Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within a max. of 6 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement
A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

The University of Napoli Federico II does not send a formal acceptance letter. Only students whose candidatures are rejected will be informed within 5 weeks.

A Transcript of records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the University of Napoli Federico II [it should normally not exceed 5 weeks according to Erasmus Chapter for Higher Education guidelines].

I NAPOLI01:

National Grading System

Each course is graded on a scale from 1 to 30, with 18 and 30 e lode (30 cum laude) as a minimum and maximum pass grade, respectively. Some exams can be evaluated by pass (superato o idoneo) or by sufficient (sufficient), good (buono), excellent (eccellente o ottimo).

Credits (1 credit = 25 hours total work)

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits.

A percentage grading distribution will be provided to each Transcript of Records, according to the single class degree and the average of the last three years.

2. Visa

The sending and receiving institutions will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outbound mobile participants, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.

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

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
