2. **RO IASIO3:** Nominated students receive by e-mail their login details to our online application form that they have to complete within the deadline above. Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within a max. of 6 weeks. **UK LEWES01:** The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement
A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
