3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **5** weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

1. Grading systems of the institutions:

HOST University:

MK TETOVO01: Macedonian grading scheme consists five grades with numerical equivalents: 10(excellent), 9 (very good), 8 (good), 7 (satisfactory), 6 (sufficient), 5 (fail). Passing grade is 6 (sufficient). Macedonian grading scheme does not have intermediate grades. State University of Tetova uses ECTS grading scale in addition to the national grade scheme.
