WORK PLACEMENTS:

At the NW Academy we have extensive experience in finding the right work placement. We work with a portfolio of more than 350 local companies and we place more than 700 participants per year.

Participants can be:

- STUDENTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION
- VET LEARNERS
- We work in cooperation with schools, universities and job offices all around europe. our aim is to find and organise work placements which are beneficial for the professional, social and personal skills of the participants.
- We prepare the participants for their experience through a work placement preparation course of 3 hours.
- Before organising the final interview, the work placement officer will meet the participants in order to understand expectations and discuss possible placements.
- Employers ultimately have the final say and may want to interview each trainee prior to offering a placement.
- Placements depend on the participant's language skills, on their motivation/ attitude to work and on their vocational training and experience.

ADDITIONAL TRAINING

NW Academy is proud to offer to its partners and students 2 new training options complementary to the language preparation and to the work placement element of the project.

1. TRINITY COLLEGE LONDON EXAM

Trinity's gese exams test the english speaking and listening skills of people whose first language is not english. They focus on building motivation and confidence in using english and enable students to chart their progress from beginner to proficiency.

We believe it is a great opportunity for the participants of mobility programmes to successfully complete their mobility experience by achieving the gese exam. The gese examination will represent an additional qualification gained during the programme and a certificate which tests their ability of speaking in english.

WORLD HOST TRAINING - PRICIPLE OF THE COSTUMER SERVICE

Over one million customer-facing staff globally have been trained on WorldHost customer service programmes. WorldHost was first developed in Canada to train 40,000 volunteers and front-line tourism staff for the Vancouver Winter Olympics in 2010 and has been adopted by People 1st and the UK Government.
