The academic board of the Animal Sciences Faculty, part of the “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine, Iasi, Romania, takes great pleasure in inviting you to the Scientific Conference **“MODERN ZOOTECHNY - FACTOR OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT”**, organised during **April, 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012**.

This traditional scientific conference, benefiting from international participation, will approach the current problems of animal husbandry from a five-angled perspective:

The papers, selected by the Scientific Board - written in English - will be burned on CDs and published in the **Lucrari Stiintifice journal, Seria Zootehnie (Ranked CNCISIS B+ and indexed in CAB I, DOAJ, COPERNICUS, AGRIS databases)**, by the **“Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University Press**, print ISSN 1454-7368 and electronic ISSN 2067-2330.

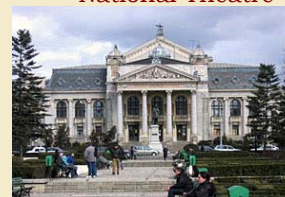

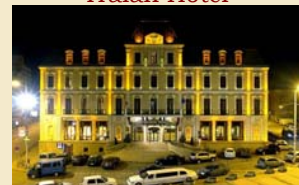

- **Geographical Location.** Romania is situated in the central part of South Eastern Europe, on the lower Danube, which has its output on the Black Sea.

- **Area of Romania** is 238,391 km<sup>2</sup>.

- **Borders:** in North East – Ukraine, in the East - Republic of Moldavia, in the South East - Black Sea, in the South - Bulgaria, in the South West - Serbia and in the West - Hungary.

- **Romania's climate** is moderate continental type with multi-average temperatures in April of between 10 and 20°C and a pluviometric between 28 and 65 l / sqm.

Built in Italian Renaissance style, the St. Paraschiva Metropolitan Cathedral is the largest Orthodox church in Romania. Construction began in 1833 and ended in 1839, but its cupolas fell and the church remained in ruins until 1880, when, with the help of the Foundation of King Carol I, work started again, lasting until 1888. The vast interior was painted in 1887 by Gheorghe Tattarescu and the stained glass windows were completed by a Bavarian factory in Munich.

**Address:** Piata Stefan cel Mare si Sfânt nr 1.

**Open:** Tue. - Sun 10:00am - 5:00pm; closed on Mondays Free admission (not including museums). This remarkable construction (1906-1925), built in flamboyant neogothic style, stands partly on the ruins of a medieval royal court mentioned in documents dating from 1434. Today, the 365-room palace houses the Gheorghe Asachi Library and four of the city's museums: the **Moldavian History Museum**, the **Ethnographic Museum**, the **Museum of Art** and the **Museum of Science and Technology** (see [museum details](#)). The interior décor, with the lavish furnishings and magnificent staircase of the entrance lobby, can be admired free of charge, but tickets are required for entry to the museums.

**Address:** Str. Agatha Barseescu 18.

Built in the late 19th century on the site of the old City Hall, this is one of the most elegant buildings in Romania. The architects were the Viennese Feller and Helmer who later built theatres in Cernauti and Sofia. Richly decorated in French-eclectic style, the theatre has one of the most splendid auditoriums in the country. It can seat 1,000 people and the acoustics are excellent. The theatre bears the name of the company's founder, Vasile Alecsandri (1821-1890), a renowned Romanian poet, playwright, politician and diplomat.

**Address:** Piata Unirii 1.

Built in neoclassical style in 1879 by an engineer, G. Fragneau, who worked with G. Eiffel & Co. in Paris (yes, the Eiffel who designed the Eiffel Tower), the hotel was one of the first in Europe to be molded on a metal frame. Throughout the years, many foreign diplomats and other personalities have stayed at the Traian.

In 1934, Greta Garbo spent some time here in secret during her love affair with John Gilbert.
