Discipline objectives (course and seminar)

The course aims is to acquire the German language of speciality by the students as an instrument of the communication, the information and the professional documentation. They will also develop skills of understanding and production of messages specific to the agronomic lexicon, and are going to update their knowledge of linguistic and cultural order, with specific contexts for the later exploitation in their professional and scientific activity.

The seminars seek to understand isolated sentences and expressions usually used in connection with the domains of immediate priority (personal information or familial, purchases, environment, work). The student will be capable to communicate in simple and usual situations, which require only an information exchange, simple and direct, on familiar and usual topics. He can describe with simple means his family, his environment and talk about familiar topics which answer to the immediate needs. In writing, the student can write a very simple personal letter.
