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**Methodology of the graduation exam at  
Faculty of Veterinary Medicine session June 2020  
(Veterinary medicine English Program)**

**(1) Exam I. *The evaluation of the fundamental and specialized knowledge*** will consist of an online test.

***The evaluation of the fundamental knowledge*** includes the following 7 subjects: Anatomy; Physiology; Pathophysiology; Pharmacology; Semiology; Microbiology; Pathological Anatomy.

***The evaluation of the specialized knowledge*** includes the clinical disciplines of expertise: Infectious diseases and preventive medicine, Pathology and surgical clinic, Pathology and medical clinic, Parasitology and parasitic diseases, Reproduction and reproductive disorders and clinical lectures on species.

The Test consists in a multiple-choice test on the Moodle e-learning platform. The exam duration is 20 minutes and comprises 20 questions with one correct answer (80% are thematic questions that are previously given to the students as examples (without answers) and 20% are thematic questions at first sight. The answer is evaluated as follows: the multiple-choice test is scored with marks from 10 to 1 (20 questions are scored with 0.45 points each and a point is awarded ex officio) and represents the final grade of the Test.

**(2) Exam II. *The oral presentation of the graduation project*** is done in front of the Examination Committee using Zoom platform, in public session with the participation of the coordinator.

(3) Failure to pass an exam (either I or II) will automatically result in the elimination of the candidate from the graduation exam.

(4) In order to pass an exam, the candidate must obtain a minimum grade of 5.00 for the test and the average of passing the graduation exam shall be a minimum of 6.00. The final score of graduation exam will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the scores obtained for Exams I and II.

(5) Once a test is passed, it will be recognized in all subsequent sessions of graduation exams, but only at the institution where the candidate have taken that exam.

**(6) The graduation exam program for the June 2020 session**

***Exam I. Evaluation of the fundamental and specialized knowledge***

Friday, **19.06.2020**, the schedule of Test will be announced on faculty website and on the Moodle e-learning platform. The Graduation Committee will prepare 3 sets of 20 questions each and pulling out will choose a final set used for exam. The final questions will be uploaded on Moodle (in "invisible" mode) and will be displayed on Friday 26.06.2020 when the test starts. The start and finish times of the test will be set using the Moodle facilities.

Appeals are submitted to the faculty secretariat by email ([secr\\_vet@uaiasi.ro](mailto:secr_vet@uaiasi.ro)) no later than 2 hours after the end of the test and will be solved in the same day till 14:00.

**(7) Exam II. Graduation project presentation**

It will take place online using Zoom platform on **Friday 26.06.2020, starting at 14:00.**

The Graduation project presentation will be held orally, in front of the Commission, in public session, in the order of the disciplines and candidates, aspects that will be displayed on Moodle and faculty website one day before.

The project will be presented orally as a Power-Point slide show (10-12 slides, maximum 10 minutes). The candidates should emphasize the stage of the research, brief bibliographic references related to the chosen topic, the material and study methods, the original results argued by iconography, graphs and tables.


***The Graduation Committee will take into account the following:***

- How to approach and solve the problem (maximum 1.5 points)
- Quality of results (maximum 2.0 points)
- Aspect of text, compliance with the drafting rules (maximum 1.5 points)
- Presentation quality and the ability to answers to committee questions (maximum 5.0 points).

Council of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine approved the present methodology.
