



Having been awarded in 2019 the **“Bienvenue en France”** label, which aims to improve the quality of the welcome and support given to international students, the International Mobility department at the University of Lille secured funding from MESRI to develop ULillGO, the only PWA (progressive web application) of its kind in France which can be used via a web browser, on tablets and smartphones. It is designed for all students on mobility at the University of Lille as well as students from Lille on mobility trips abroad, offering them high-quality support for administrative and academic procedures and a wide range of communicational tools and information dedicated to international mobility.

This ensures international students hosted at the University of Lille to receive information about the following at regular intervals throughout their mobility trip: accommodation, catering, campus life, cultural activities and events organised by the Maison Internationale. Outgoing students will also find plenty of useful information to help prepare their mobility trip abroad.

ULillGo accompanies students on exchange programmes as well as Free Movers before, during and after their mobility trips, making the various procedures as easy as possible: how to get to Lille, how to find accommodation, where to access healthcare, the grants they may be entitled to, and how to prepare for a mobility trip abroad. Answers to all these questions can be found via the application, with simple and intuitive browsing.

What’s more, once the application has been downloaded and its content consulted, everything continues to be accessible offline!
