2. RO IASI03:

3. RO IASIO3: Each faculty issues Transcripts of Records (documenting credits earned at the USAMV Iasi). Every student must pick their transcript him-/herself up. If the exam grades are not yet available until student's departure he/she is obliged to arrange sending Transcript of Records to the home institution.

PL OLSZTYN01: Each faculty issues Transcripts of Records (documenting credits earned at the UWM in Olsztyn). Every student must pick their transcript him-/herself up. If the exam grades are not yet available until student's departure he/she is obliged to arrange sending Transcript of Records to the home institution.

4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
