TR GIRESUN01:

Students should send their application form, learning agreements and the official document indicating they have been nominated by their home institution to erasmus@giresun.edu.tr by the deadline. After having received the paper application (printed online application) the letter of acceptance will be sent within a max. of four weeks.

Staff should also inform the Erasmus Office by sending their application form, work plan and the official document indicating they have been nominated by their home institution.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given.

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
